JEA Annual Celebration

The **JEA Annual Celebration** will take place at **Elim Rock**, Plat Douet Road, at 6.30pm on **Sunday, 15th March 2015**.

We are privileged to have Paul Perkin from St Mark's Battersea Rise, as our speaker. Paul is married to Christine, and is the father of three children in their twenties, and guardian of a Yamaha sports motor-bike. Previously a physicist and teacher, since ordination in the Church of England he has served in a dockyard parish, and then at Holy Trinity Brompton, where he was also hospital chaplain of the Brompton Hospital. Since 1987, he has led a church plant at St Mark's Battersea Rise, and sent plants to regenerate two other churches. Together with Christine he leads the church, and has written the Parenting Teenagers Course under New Wine's Family Time programme.

He has been involved in ministry among prisoners, and in the rehabilitation of ex-offenders. He has set up and chairs the local Junction Community Trust coordinating community ministries

He chairs the Fellowship of Confessing Anglicans in the UK, Ireland, and Europe, and is on the Executive Committee of AMiE (The Anglican Mission in England).
